DOUBLING AND ELECTRIFICATION OF DAUND-MANMAD RAIL LINE

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Government propose to double and electrify Daund-Manmad rail line and carry out survey work for laying of the proposed Nagar-Beed-Parli new rail line and provide loan for it from the Capital market; and

(b) if so, the time limit fixed therefor and if not, the reasons therefor?

(a) and (b): A survey for doubling with electrification of Daund-Manmad line is in progress. Further consideration of the project would be possible once the survey report becomes available.

The work of construction of new line from Ahmednagar-Beed-Parli-Vaijnath is in hand and would be progressed and completed in the coming years with Railways' own resources as per availability of funds.

There is no proposal at present to raise loan from the capital market for the above two projects.
