(a),(b) and (c): Airlines are free to operate on any route in their commercial judgement subject to compliance with the Route Dispersal Guidelines which stipulate certain minimum operations on specified category of routes. Indian Airlines has no plans to restart operation on this route which was discontinued in December, 1998 due to inadequate passenger demand.
