- (a): The work was started in the year 1994-95.
- (b): The cost of the project is Rs. 217.82 crs. and an amount of Rs. 115.01 crs. has been spent so far.
- (c): The budget allotment in 1999-2000 was Rs. 28 crs.
- (d): Arsikere-Hassan (46.66 km) was commissioned on 23.8.96 and Hassan to Sakleshpur (42.06 km) was commissioned on 26.01.98. The work on Sakleshpur-Kankanadi (142 km) is in good progress and will be completed in a phased manner. No firm target date has yet been fixed for the completion of the project.
