- (a) the progress made regarding Gauge conversion work of Quilon-Tenkasi-Tirunelveli meter gauge line in Southern Railway;

- (c) whether any gauge conversion work has been started in Quilon-Sihengotin section; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

- (a):On Virudhnagar-Tenkasi and Tirunelveli-Tiruchendur bridge work and earthwork have been taken up. Final location survey in the ghat section between Quilon and Tenkasi has been recently completed.
- (b): Anticipated cost of the project is Rs. 327.6 crore. The expenditure incurred upto March 2001 is Rs. 21.97 crores.
- (c) & (d): Final Location Survey has been completed. Preparation of plans and estimate have been taken up.
