NEW RAIL LINE BETWEEN BIJWASAN AND BAHADURGARH

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has undertaken a survey for a new rail line between Bijwasan and Bahadurgarh;
- (b) if so, the details and outcome thereof; and
- (c) the action taken by the Government thereon?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI BANDARU DATTATRAYA)

(a): Yes, Sir.

(b) & (c) : A survey for construction of new broad gauge rail line between Bijwasan to Bahadurgarh (36 km.) was conducted in March` 2000. As per survey report, the cost of construction of this line has been assessed as Rs. 111.58 crore with a rate of return as (-) 6.94%. In view of heavy throwforward and limited availability of resources, it has not been found feasible to take up the work.
