- (b) the amount spent so far on construction of the said railway line;
- (c) the funds required for the completion of the railway line; and

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI DIGVIJAY SINGH)

- (a): No target date of completion has been fixed.
- (b): Rs.34.27 crores have been spent upto the financial year 1999-2000 and a sum of Rs 6 crores has been allocated for the current financial year.
- (c): The anticipated cost of the project is Rs.175.30 crores.
- (d): The outlay for this project is proposed to be increased to Rs.8 crores
