- (a) whether Railways propose to introduce satellite controlled `anti-collision devices' on all important routes in the country to prevent accidents;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the routes on which the anti-collision devices likely to be introduced during the first phase ?

(a) to (c) Indian Railways have proposed to try the recently developed "Anti-Collision Device" (ACD) by Konkan Railway Corporation through a pilot project. In the first instance, it is proposed to introduce this pilot project on North East Frontier Railway and based on the performance evaluation of this pilot project, the use of this device on other important routes will be considered.
