(a) to (d): A case was registered in Jamnagar by Jamnagar Police on 24.9.2002 on the complaint of Railway staff.A bunch of reservation forms was seized from the premises of a suspect who was later arrested by Police and sent to judicial custody. The case is under trial. No Railway official has been found involved in this case.
