MINISTER OF TOURISM AND CULTURE (SHRI ANANTH KUMAR)

(a) Yes, Sir. Thirty four centrally protected monuments under the Archaeological Survey of India have been identified for upgradation.

(b) to (d) : The proposals include conservation & preservation of monuments, environmental upgradation, providing information centres, souvenir shops, cafeterias, car parking, toilets and improved signages.

The implementation of the proposals will depend upon the availability of funds.
