- (c) the funds utilised out the Special Railway Safety Fundto wipe out the arrears of replacement/renewals work during the last one year, zone-wise; and
- (d) the replacement/renewals work carried out by the Railways in the country particularly in Maharashtra during the last one year, State-wise?

- (a) & (b): Despite the improvement in the Railways' financial position over the last two years, the Railways' internal generation is not adequate enough to fully take care of funds required for complete replacements/renewals. The Government, in 2001-02, constituted a Special Railway Safety Fund (SRSF) of Rs.17000 cr to wipe out the arrears of replacement/renewals in a fixed time schedule of six years. The amount of Rs.17000 cr includes a contribution of Rs.12000 cr from the Government as dividend free budgetary support and the balance of Rs.5000 cr is to be raised by the Railways through levy of a safety surcharge on passenger fares, over a period of six years.
- (c): The zone-wise net expenditure on replacement/ renewal works under Special Railway Safety Fund for the year 2002-03 is as under:-
