- (e) whether the poor quality of wheels has caused several accidents; and
- (f) if so, the steps proposed to acquire high quality wheels?

STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PART(S) to (f) OF LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION No. 646 BY PRC UMMAREDDY VENKATESWARLU TO BE ANSWERED ON 11.5.2000 REGARDING REQUIREMENT OF LOCO WHEELS

- (a) The annual requirement of loco wheels on Indian Railways is about 33,000 wheels.
- (b) & (c) The units which are supplying loco wheels are listed in Appendix I.S ince the indigenous capacity for manufacture of loco wheels is still inadequate to meet full requirements of Indian Railways, imports are resorted to cover the shortfall. However, the Railways are pursuing the policy of increasing domestic production.
- d) The details are given in Appendix II.
- e) No Sir. Only one case of derailment of a MG locomotive was reported during year 1997 due to breakage of wheel.
- f) The manufacturing and quality assurance facilities of the Romanian supplier of the wheel which failed causing derailment, were inspected and certain remedial measures to ensure consistency in quality were advised to the firm. Further procurement from this firm has been stopped till such time the remedial measures are taken by the firm to ensure high level of consistency in quality.
