Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of times the General Manager, Western Railway made inspection visits to Agra in a saloon during each of the last two years ;
- (b) the criteria for paying such visits in a Saloon;
- (c) the number of times usually a General Manager makes inspection visits to a particular place in a year;
- (d) whether the visits to Agra by the General Manager are justified and permitted by the rules ;
- (e) if not, the reasons for the excessive visits; and
- (f) the total amount spent by the Railways on these visits ?

(a) &(b) The General Manager made 3 inspections at Agra during 1998-2000 as under:

(i) General Manager's Annual inspection at Jamuna Bridge/Agra Fort and trailing window inspection of Agra Fort - Gangapur City - Sawai Madhopur on 24.2.1998 Arr: Agra Fort 08.10 hrs. and Dep: 09.00 hrs.

(ii) General Manager's Annual inspection of Kota Division on Agra Fort- Bayana - Sawai Madhopur on 5.3.1999 Arr: Agra Fort 10.00 hrs. and Dep. 11.00 hrs.

(iii) General Manager's inspection of Jamuna Bridge/Agra Fort and trailing window inspection at Agra Fort - Gangapur City section on 2.8.1999 Arr: Agra Fort 08.00 hrs. and Dep: 16.00 hrs.

(c) No norm has been fixed in this regard.

(e) Does not arise.

(f) No separate account for inspection is maintained.
