- (b) if so, the total revenue lost thereby during the last three years; and

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI DIGVIJAY SINGH)

- (a) No, Sir. There has been no loss of revenue as Railways charge freight according to the prescribed classification. Classification of a commodity is fixed by the Government based on the capacity of the commodity to bear a particular level of freight.
