EXPANSION OF AIRPORTS IN MADHYA PRADESH

Will the Minister of CIVIL AVIATION be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of airports in Madhya Pradesh suitable for passenger planes which have so far been approved by the Union Government;
- (b) the number of airports out of them for whom expansion, financial and technical assistance has been provided by the Union Government during the last three years; and
- (c) the details of progress made in expansion works being carried out by Union Government?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF CIVIL AVIATION (SHRI SHARAD YADAV)

- (a) :- The airports at Bhopal, Raipur, Indore, Khajuraho, Jabalpur and Gwalior are in operation in Madhya Pradesh.
- (b) & (c) :- Airports Authority of India has undertaken expansion/modification of Terminal buildings and resurfacing of runways etc. at Bhopal, Raipur, Indore, and runway at Jabalpur has been extended and strengthened for operation of Boeing-737 aircraft during the last three years in Madhya Pradesh.
