- (a) and (b): A sper Interim Report of the Task Force on Human Resource Development (HRD), there were 3,40,000 Software professionals employed in the country as on 31st March, 2001.
- (c),(d) and (e): As per NASSCOM StrategicReview 2001, countries like France, Germany, Italy, UK, Irelandhave critical shortage of IT professionals. With a view to attract IT professionals from India, these countries have initiated relaxed immigration measures. Approximate demand for IT professionals in these countries are: Germany 20,000; France 15,000; UK 30,000 and Italy 10,000.
