- (a) whether the Government of Karnataka has urged the centre to release funds for grantin-aid to the State Tribal Development Cooperation for minor forest produce (MFP) for the year 2000-2001;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the time by which the said funds are likely to be released?

Answer

MINISTER OF TRIBAL AFFAIRS (SHRI JUAL ORAM)

(a) to (c) The State Government of Karnataka has sent a proposal for release of Rs. 40.00 lakhs to them underthe State Tribal Development Cooperative Corporation Scheme for the year 2001-02. They have sought the money forstrengthening the working capital of LAMP Societies, strengthening share capital as well as to establish twoprocessing units. The State Government, however, is yet to furnish details sought by this Ministry on their proposal.
