(a), (b), (c) & (d) Under the programme of Coastal Monitoring and Prediction System (COMAPS), coastal water quality is monitored at 82 locations in coastal States. The programme is sponsored by the Department of Ocean Development since 1990-91 and an amount of Rs. 504.80 lakhs has been so far spent. The programme is implemented through various agencies including Central and State Pollution Control Boards.
