- (a) No, Sir.
- (b) & (c): However, the Group of Ministers set up to review the management of defence and to consider the recommendations of the Kargil Review Committee have set up a Task Force under the Chairmanship of Shri Arun Singh. The terms of reference of the Task Force, inter-alia, include recommending such organisational and other changes as are considered appropriate to bring about improvements in the procurement process, keeping in view the imperative of ensuring accountability for proper expenditure of public funds, as also the need to have time bound decisions.
