Will the Minister of FINANCE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the benefit of reservation has not provided to the employees belonging to the Scheduled Castes/tribes of the public sector banks particularly Bank of Maharashtra while promoting them from clerical category to officer category and from subordinate category to clerical category during the year 2000-2001 under internal promotion system;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the steps taken by the Government for filling the posts under the reservation policy?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE (SHRI GINGEE N. RAMACHANDRAN):

(a) to (c) Benefit of reservation is provided to the employees belonging to the Scheduled Castes/tribes of the public sector banks as per orders of Government of India issued from time to time for reservation for Scheduled Castes/Tribes .

The Bank of Maharashtra has reported that reservation for SC/ST is provided as per Government Guidelines issued from time to time. Accordingly, the benefit of reservation has been provided to the employees of the bank while promoting them from clerical category to officer category and from subordinate category to clerical category during the year 2000-2001 under its internal promotion system.
