Will the Minister of FINANCE AND COMPANY AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the State Government of Andhra Pradesh requested to consider 100 percent exemption under Section 80-G of the Income Tax Act, 1961 for the donations made for the construction of cultural complex at Hyderabad; and
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the action taken by the Union Government thereon?

Answer

- (a): Yes, Sir.
- (b): Under Section 80G, 100% deduction is only allowed for donations made to funds of national importance or to certain State funds for disaster management and medical relief to the poor. On satisfaction of the stipulated conditions, donations made to the A.P. Cultural Fund would be eligible for 50% deduction.
