(a) and (b) Yes, Sir. The Madhya Pradesh Government have developed Ghatigaon Great Indian Bustard Sanctuary in Gwalior District and Kerala Sanctuary in Shivpuri District and have incurred following expenditure during the last three years.

The expenditure has been incurred on habitat improvement, patrolling camp, wireless tower, staff quarters, road improvement, grass development, construction of community and conservation education centre, and pay and allowance of staff.
