- (b) if so, the details thereof, State-wise alongwith the causes of contamination of ground water;
- (c) whether the Government has reviewed the functioning of Central Ground Water Board;
- (d) if so, the outcome of the review; and
- (e) the steps being taken up by the Government to provide safe drinking water to the people of such areas where the ground water is not fit for human consumption?

STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (e) OF LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO.158 FOR 08.12.9 DR. SUSHIL KUMAR INDORA AND SHRI SULTAN SALAHUDDIN OWAISI REGARDING UNDERGROUND WATER.

- (a) & (b) Long term observations made by the Central Ground Water Board have shown a situation of fall in the level of ground water in various parts of the country. The names of the States/districts showing pockets where fall in ground water level for more than 4 meters (1980- 1999) has been observed are indicated in Statement I. The names of the States and locations where ground water has been found contaminated and reasons thereof is indicated in Statement II.
- (c) & (d) The functions of the Central Ground Water Board has been reviewed by a Committee headed by Shri P.V. Rangayya Naidu which has already submitted its report. With a view to examine the recommendations made by the Rangayya Naidu Committee, a Empowered Committee has been set up.
- (e) Provision for providing safe drinking water is planned, financed and implemented by the State Governments. The Central Ground Water Board provide technical services to the State Governments in this endeavour. Further the Department of Drinking Water Supply in the Ministry of Rural Development and Ministry of Urban Development extend financial and technical support to the State Governments in their efforts to supply safe drinking water, in such areas.
