(a) & (b): India's Integrated Guided Missile Development Programme is progressing as planned. Prithvi surface-to-surface missile system has already been inducted. Agni II, the longer range version of Agni has been successfully flight tested. Government closely monitors all developments related to missile capabilities and strategic modernization programmes in the region and beyond. Government remains fully committed to taking all necessary steps to safeguard the nation's security in accordance with its own assessment of threats to our security.
