(a) to (c) : A Group of Ministers comprising Deputy Chairman, Planning Commission, Ministers of Labour, Heavy Industries & Public Enterprises, Power, Parliamentary Affairs and Information Technology, Commerce and Industry, Textiles, Surface Transport & Finance has been constituted.

The Group of Ministers is to consider & make recommendations in respect of the issues relating to payment of wages, salaries and statutory dues of employees in Central Public Undertakings, etc., besides examining the proposals relating to (1) Amendment to the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 and (2) New Legislation for Regulation of Employment and Conditions of Service of Contract Labour in India. No time limit has been fixed by which the Group may submit its report.
