3. Rajasthan Health System Development Project
4. Tamilnadu Health System Development Project
5. Assam Health System Development Project
6. Technical Education Quality Improvement Project of Government of India.

These projects are at various stages of consideration in the World Bank. No time limit can be given for approval of these projects by the World Bank.
