- (a) and (b) No, Sir. The Genera! Insurers` (Public Sector) Association of India (GIPSA) have reported that while existing insurance policies are renewed as per the normal practice, fresh policies are issued after inspection of the risk as per the underwriting requirement.
- (c) and (d) The GIPSA have reported that the public Sector General Insurance Companies have received about 5000 claims amounting to about Rs.173 crores.
