- (c) to what extent it has been utilized by the State Government to revamp co-operative credit system?

(a) to (c) Union Government has received a proposal from Government of Karnataka forsanction of Rs. 742.60 crores for rehabilitating the cooperative credit structure. Decision on this proposal will be taken once the details of the scheme for rehabilitation of cooperatives announced in the Union Budget for the year 2002-2003 have been worked out.
