UPLIFTMENT OF JUANG TRIBES
ANANTA NAYAK

Will the Minister of TRIBAL AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government have launched any scheme for the welfare and upliftment of Juang Tribes in Orissa;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether any review has been made on the implementation of those schemes;
- (d) if so, the outcome of the review; and
- (e) the various steps taken to identify and resolve the problem of these micro tribes?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF TRIBAL AFFAIRS (SHRI JUAL ORAM):

- (a) and (b) The Government of Orissa have taken a micro project for the upliftment of the Juang tribe in Orissa. The Government of India also provides Central Assistance to the State Government/NGOs under the Central Sector Scheme for the Development of PTGs including the Juang tribe.
- (c) to (e) The Government of India reviews the implementation of the Schemes annually. The Government of Orissa has also conducted a baseline survey of Primitive Tribe Groups and will submit an action plan for the development of PTGs in the State including Juangs.
