- (a) whether there has been any discussion amongst the insurance Regulatory Development Authority, the Psychiatrists, the Government and a newly formed 'Schizophrenia Support Group' for insurance schemes for Schizophrenics and mentally afflicted persons;

- (c) whether any schemes have been evolved to extend such insurance support; and
