- (a) Yes, Sir.
- (b) & (c): During the last three years there has been one case in 1999 when on 10th August, 1999, a Pakistan Navy Atlantique combat aircraft while carrying out aerial reconnaissance and photography mission on our territory was engaged by our Air Defence interceptors and shot down well inside the Indian air space.
