Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of schemes sanctioned and implemented under the Revised Central Rural Sanitation Programme since its inception, State-wise;
- (b) the number of community lavatories constructed under the scheme, State-wise;
- (c) the total funds allocated/sanctioned and spent under the scheme so far State-wise;
- (d) whether the Government have evaluated the scheme; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof and achievements made under the scheme ?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT (SHRI ANNASAHEB M.K. PATIL):

(a) to (e) The Revised Central Rural Sanitation Programme (RCRSP) was implemented with effect from 1.4.1999. During 1.4.99 and 31.3.2002, RCRSP had (a) Allocation based Programme and (5) Total Sanitation Campaign. The Allocation Based Programme was phased out with effect from March, 2002. In the RCRSP, the Total Sanitation Campaign is being implemented on `Project mode` in 185 districts in the country. Details of funds released under Allocation Based Programme and TSC programme are given in the statement-I and II enclosed respectively. As per the reports received from the State/UT/District, the details of community lavatories constructed under the scheme, Statewise is given in the statement III. The revised CRSP has not been evaluated, however monitoring is done at the State and Central level.
