(b) whether any extension centres are established to assist the farmers to grow Orange;

(c) if so, the places where these Centres have been set up;

(d) whether the climatic conditions and soil of Pallahara area in Oissa is suitable for growing Orange; and

(e) if so, the steps taken to assist the local farmers in this area to grow Orange?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE

MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE (SHRI MULLAPPALLY RAMACHANDRAN): (a) The Government of India are implementing two scheme for the development of fruit trees which include oranges also,

(i) establishment of nutritional gardens in rural areas;

(ii) Central Sector Scheme on Integrated Development of Tropical and Arid Zone Fruits

besides, the State Governments also provide assistance for development of different fruit crops including oranges.

(b) and (c). Central Government is not establishing extension centres to assist farmers to grow oranges. However, State Governments are having extension services for different crops which include oranges also.

(d) and (e). Yes, Sir, Quality planting material is raised in the departmental farms and nurseries. The farmers are being provided technical known-now and other inputs.
