THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE

MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE (SHRI MULLAPPALLY RAMACHANDRAN): (a) The Government of India are implementing two scheme for the development of fruit trees which include oranges also,

- (i) establishment of nutritional gardens in rural areas;
- (ii) Central Sector Scheme on Integrated Development of Tropical and Arid Zone Fruits

besides, the State Governments also provide assistance for development of different fruit crops including oranges.

- (b) and (c). Central Government is not establishing extension centres to assist farmers to grow oranges. However, State Governments are having extension services for different crops which include oranges also.
- (d) and (e). Yes, Sir, Quality planting material is raised in the departmental farms and nurseries. The farmers are being provided technical known-now and other inputs.
