## Will the Minister of FINANCE be pleased to state:

(a) whether the financial institutions and some banks have constituted a `Crisis Resolution Group` (CRG) to find means to make some sectors financially viable;

(b) if so, whether IDBI, ICICI, TDFC and IFCI are members of this CRG;

(c) if so, whether they have over-extended themselves in financing power projects;

(d) if so, the extent to which such unsafe loans has put these financial institutions risk;

(e) if so, the details thereof; and

(f) the action taken by the Government to examine the matter ?

## Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE (SHRI BALASAHEB VIKHE PATIL):

(a) and (b) No. Sir. `Criiis Resolution Group` (CRG) has been constituted by Ministryof Power (MoP) under the Chairmanship of the Minister of Power to resolve the `Last Mile` problems of the power projects. IDBI. ICICI, IDFC and IFCI are members of the CRG.
