- (b) if so, whether this matter was taken up by the Government of Jammu and Kashmir at several times in the past stressing that in the absence of adequate proof regarding derivation of Shahtoosh wool from slaughtered animals, processing and trade of Shahtoosh Wool should continue to be allowed as before:
- (c) if so, the steps taken in this regard;
- (d) whether fresh Committee has been constituted with experts to verify the truth regarding derivation of wool from slaughtered animals; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof?
