- (a): As per information furnished by the Indian Nursing Council, Seven Schools and one college have applied to the Council for starting GNM & BSc. (Nursing) Programmes respectively.
- (b): The Government of Rajasthan has intimated that the procedure for the admissions in private nursing schools and colleges would be as per the criteria laid down by Hon'ble Supreme Court in case of Unnikrishanan J.P. versus State of Andhra Pradesh and others;
- (c): No, Sir. The Nursing institutions are recognised by the Indian Nursing Council.
