(a) and (b): At present, following scheduled air services are availble to/from Leh in Ladakh region:

Sector Frequency/week

Indian Airlines:

Delhi-Leh-Delhi 4 (upto 31/8/2000)

Alliance Air:

Delhi-Leh-Delhi 4
Leh-Srinagar-Leh 1

Leh-Jammu-Leh Leh-Chandigarh-Leh

Alliance air is also operating additional air services on Delhi-Leh-Delhisector with a frequency of 4 flights/week w.e.f. 15.6.2000 to 10.9.2000.

Private airlines have also been asked to consider operating more flights to Leh. However, it is upto the airlines to provide air services to specific places depending upon the traffic demand and commercial viability subject to compliance of route dispersal guidelines issued by Government.
