## Will the Minister of COMMUNICATIONS be pleased to state:

(a) the number of persons on the waiting list for telephone connections and STD/ISD/PCO booths in Karnataka, district-wise ;
(b) the number of applications lying pending for installation of said connections for the last three years till date ;
(c) whether any special efforts are being made to clear the backlog ; and
(d) if so, the details thereof and the time by which the said backlog is likely to be cleared?

## Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE FOR COMMUNICATIONS (SHRI TAPAN SIKDAR)
a) $3,13,831$ persons are waiting for new telephone connections and 2746 persons are waiting for STD/ISD PCOs as on 30-06-2000. District-wise waiting list for new telephone connections and STD/ISD PCOs is given in Annexure.
b) The number of applicants lying pending for installations for more than three years are as follows:

STD/ISD PCOs : NIL
```

c) \& d) All the above pending connections except the long distance connections are planned to be cleared by March 2001 and the long distance connections will be provided progressively during the year 2001 on availability of new technology equipment such as Wireless in Local Loop equipment.
