THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE (SHRI HUKUMDEO NARAYAN YADAV)

- (a): Yes, Sir.
- (b) & (c): The Group of Ministers has endorsed the proposal with the recommendation that a provision be introduced in the Bill that the Government of India shall frame rules containing general guidelines for regulation of Aquaculture to ensure that it is not detrimental to the coastal environment. The Aquaculture Authority Bill, 2000 was thereafter introduced in the Rajya Sabha on 28.2.2000, and has been subsequently referred to the Parliament Standing Committee on Agriculture for examination.
