(a) & (b) Government has seen media reports indicating that Pakistan would not object to an overland gas pipeline to India through Pakistan as it would be economically beneficial for Pakistan. The proposal of a gas pipeline from Iran to India is a bilateral matter between India and Iran. A Joint Committee consisting of officials from India and Iran has been constituted to consider all aspects relating to the transfer of Iranian gas to India.
