Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) Whether the Government are aware that a large number of non-affiliated schools are flourishing in the country as showing themselves affiliated with the CBSE falsely;
- (b) if so, the number of such schools detected so far;
- (c) the action taken/proposed to be taken against these schools, and
- (d) the steps being taken by the Government to make the students aware of such schools?

Answer

THE MINSTER OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (DR. MURLI MANOHAR JOSHI)

- (a) to (c): As per the information received from the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE), a totahumber of 15 unaffiliated schools have so far been detected in different parts of the country which are being run by making false claim about their affiliation with the CBSE. In 8 cases, show cause notices have been served and in the remaining cases, suitable action has been initiated against defaulter institutions.
- (d): Public notice warning the students/parents about the activities of the schools misusing the name of the CBSEhas been issued by the Board in all the leading newspapers in the country.

List of CBSE affiliated schools has been supplied to all UT/State Education Departments to identify functioning of unaffiliated schools under their respective jurisdiction.

Instructions have been issued to the Heads of the schools affiliated with CBSE tomention CBSEaffiliation code no. in their future press notification/advertisement.
