- (c) The State-wise seasonal requirements of urea are assessed in consultation with State Governments. The assessed requirement is met through supplies as per the allocation made under the Fertiliser Control Order. Additional allocations are also made to the States during the course of the season whenever required. The supplies within the State is the responsibility of the State Government.
