(a) to (c) No proposal for Flood Control Measure in Baitarani RiverBasin has been received in Central Water Commission. However, modernisation of 19,700 hectares out of the total command of 32,700 hectares of Baitarani Irrigation System is already included under World Bank assisted ongoing Orissa Water Resources Consolidation Project.
