The Telecommunication Tariff Order, 1999 had stipulated a general review of the effect of the 1st tranche of the rebalancing exercise, on revenues/traffic. The TRAI Secretariat has accordingly started collecting the data from operators with a view to conduct the review. A final view will be taken by the reconstituted Authority in due course.
