- (e) & (f): Exim Bank brought out an occasional paper on Indian Handicrafts in May, 2000. The study conducted by them reveals that there is a need to improve Indian export penetration of handicrafts in sizeable market such as France, Netherlands, Italy, Switzerland, Canada, Japan and Hongkong wherein the presence of our export is negligible. However, as per the data available the export of handicrafts to these countries is satisfactory and these countries are among the top ten importers of handicrafts from India.
