- (a): whether the Government are aware that life saving medicine `rabies immunoglobulin` for rabies is not available for quite some time in the market resulting in great difficulty to rabies patients;
- (b): if so, the reasons therefore; and
- (c): the steps taken or proposed to be taken to make this life saving medicine available?

(a) to (c): Yes, Sir. The shortage of some medicines of `Rabies immunoglobulin` used for treatment of rabies was reported by Drug Controller, Delhi for the month of April, 2000. The matter was taken up with the manufacturers to send supply and as confirmed by the Drug Controller, Delhi, there is no shortage of these medicines at present.
