MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS (SHRI SANTOSH KUMAR GANGWAR) (a to c): Protocols have been signed at the Third meeting of Inter-Governmental Indo-Kazakhstan Joint Commission on Trade, Economic, Scientific and Technical co-operation held in March, 1999 for promoting and strengthening co-operation between the two countries including the hydrocarbon sector. No concrete proposal has so far been firmed up.
