- (d) if so, the reaction of the Union Government thereto?

a) & b): Average prices realised by farmers of Andhra Pradesh and Karnataka during the last 3 years are:

Average Prices realised (Rs/Kg)

Year Andhra Pradesh Karnataka

1997 40.00 48.95
1998 40.12 34.47
1999 34.85 42.07

The price trend has been mixed. Declines have occurred due to supply exceeding domestic and international demand.

(c) & (d): Farmers have made representations for remunerative prices. Government has encouraged crop sizes based on projected domestic and international demand, curbing excess production and through market intervention when deemed necessary.
