VSNL had an annual growth rate of about 180%, before the sector opened and it dropped to about 71% later

MTNL started its Internet Services on 9th Feb 1999, only after opening up of the Internet serviceSector and therefore % growth year wise not given.

- (i) Government is providing access to the nearest Internet Node on local call basis in all the District Headquarters of the country except Kargil and Poonch in J & K State.
- (ii) 20% concessions on rental for leased lines for Internet access is being given by Government at present.
- (iii) Recognized Educational Institute/Government organisations/Newspapers and News Agencies are presently being given 50% concession on port charges by Government. 100% Export Oriented Units(having annual export turn over above US \$ 1,00.000). Software exporters are also getting 20% concession on annual port charges.

(iv) It is proposed to open Internet Dhabas in all Block Headquarters of the country by March, 2001.
