(a) whether 1st and II nd ACP are granted on completion of 12 years and 24 years of regular service, to the CGHS Pharmacists of Allopathic System of Medicine in Delhi;

(b) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor;

(c) the reasons for the grant of 1st and IInd ACP to Ayurvedic Pharmacists and 1st ACP to Homoeopathic and Unani Pharmacists of CGHS;

(d) whether any proposal is under consideration of the Government to finalise the ACP of the CGHS Pharmacists;

(e) if so, the time by which it is likely to be finalised; and

(f) if not, the reasons therefor?

(a) & (b) 1st and II nd Assured Career Progression has not been granted to allopathic Pharmacists working under CGHS as certain clarification is awaited from the Department of Personnel & Training.

(c) In the cadre of the Ayurvedic, Homeopathic and Unani Pharmacists in CGHS, Assured Career Progression has been granted in these cadres as they fulfilled all the criteria prescribed under the scheme.
